

LABOR DAY TOURNAMENT EXCESSIVE HEAT PLAN – Please read & be aware.

During the Labor Day Friendlies Tournament, BASC will be utilizing the US Soccer Heat & Hydration protocol set forth by US Soccer. The BASC Tournament Staff will be using the US Soccer Heat Guidelines and Wet Bulb Globe Temperature method (WBGT) of determining match play, water breaks or match cancellations throughout the day.

**** Heat Plan For Tournament Matches - WBGT Category 3 ****

82.2 to 87.0 WBGT: One water break during each half. The clock will not stop for water breaks.

87.1 to 90.0 WBGT: Two water breaks during each half. The clock will not stop for water breaks.

90.1 to 91.9 WBGT: Two water breaks during each half and match halves are reduced by 5 minutes each. The clock will not stop for water breaks.

92.0 & above WBGT: Air Horn will be blown by Tournament Director and all matches will be considered complete if at least one half has elapsed. If one half of the match has not elapsed and the match is stopped, penalty kicks will determine the final score of the stopped match. All unplayed scheduled matches will be played as penalty kicks at an earlier match time TBD. Communications with PK times will be sent to coaches via email and posted on the Tournament webpage.
